

Ever After Wedding Ceremonies

Weddings are very special. Here are some tips for planning your wedding ceremony to make sharing your commitment to each other meaningful.

First Steps:

- Book the marriage officiant as soon as you know your wedding date.
- Book the location. (ie Church, chapel, hall, garden etc.... Have a back up plan if you are having an outside wedding.)

Who will walk you down the aisle?

How many bridesmaids/groomsmen will you have?

Will there be live singing or cd music for the processional/recessional and signing of the register?

Will you have readings, poems, scripture?

Will you share in communion together?

Where will the bridal party stand during the ceremony?

Will you have a ring bearer/flower girl?

Will you light a unity candle; have a sand ceremony or hand ceremony, etc?

Will you write your own vows?

How will the church/hall/chapel be decorated?

Will you provide a wedding program with the order of service and list of participants for your guests?
